Level 0 No Awareness

- Not participating.
- Preventing others from learning.
- Disruptive behavior, needing frequent reminders from teacher.
- No respect for the rights and feelings of others.

Level 1 Awareness

- Able to participate appropriately, but not doing it often enough.
- Sometimes students are preventing others from learning.
- Needing frequent reminders from teacher.
- Sometimes, students are able to show respect for the rights and feelings of others.

Level 2 Involvement and *Cooperation*

- Most students are only doing just enough to get by.
- Only giving a little effort. Some cooperation, but more is needed.
- Only a few students are working at practicing and improving their skills.
- Many students need lots of reminders.

Level 3 Self Control and *Respect*

- Good effort is given, but not enough students are giving their best effort.
- Some teacher reminders are given to individual students.
- Students are showing some Respect, but more is required.

Level 4 Understanding and *Inclusion*

- Students have positive attitudes.
- They work independently and are self-motivated.
- Students are including others in activities.
- No teacher reminders needed.
- A pleasant atmosphere for all.

Level 5 WOW! *Integrity, Compassion*

- Students are supporting, helping, and encouraging each other.
- Going above and beyond what is expected.
- Self-directed learners.
- Atmosphere is positive, supportive, and encouraging for all.
