Planning: Story Board

Draw illustrations of that show how members of the group will form each letter

- Assign a photographer/choreographer for each shot
- Letters must be divided equally among all your group members
- Clearly label all participants
- Brainstorm a list of at least five words that start with your letter.
 - Words must be appropriate for your young audience –

Production

- Note which camera you will be using.
 - Import and erase camera contents before the end of each class
 - Back up photos to all group member's servers in a new folder called "ABC Book"
- Using the story board, the photographer/choreographer will instruct group members to properly form each letter.
- Photograph your team members as they form the letters.
- If more than one shot was taken of a given letter, pick the best one.
- Crop, rotate, and edit images in iPhoto.
- Import the photos to your laptop's iPhoto library.
- Add photos into an album in iPhoto. "ABC Book"

Publication

- Create a new book in iPhoto. Title: "ATA Alphabet Book"
 - Type the names of your group members in the title area.
 - In the description section, list who did which letters.
 - Example: Johny: A, G, H, K, M
- Add a separate page for each letter, in alphabetical order.
 - Include the photo you took.
 - Type the letter at the top of each page.
 - Type your list of words for each letter in the caption area at the bottom of the page.
- Make one last page that has something creative or unique a "Thanks For Reading" message, an alphabet-related photomontage, an ArtRage illustration of your favorite letters, etc.
- Save your book as a PDF: File > Print > PDF > Save as PDF...
- Copy your PDF file to the Nemo Drop Box.
