



Video Production: Important Information

All video production students agree to the following:

Camera Use Guidelines

- Turn off camera when not in use to save battery.
- Cameras must be plugged in to a charger at the end of each class.
- Always hold cameras with two hands, and use hand strap.
- Walk while holding camera.
- Close lens cover when not actively filming.
- Do not touch the lens.
- Wrap and return all cables when finished importing.
- Import footage before the end of each class and rewind your tape.

Filming Guidelines

- Recording should be done outside of the computer lab.
- Use indoor voices; do not disrupt other classes.
- Appropriate language only.
- Other students and classes should not be filmed without permission.
- Be safe: Do not stage unsafe events or violate school rules.

Editing Guidelines

- Do not modify, delete or otherwise tamper with other students' files.
- All audio must be removed from clips before narrations are added.
- All digital effects must enhance – not detract from – professionalism.

Group Participation Guidelines

- Roles and tasks should be distributed evenly in the group.
- All students are expected to film, import, edit and narrate.
- Individual student grades will reflect their participation levels.
- Group member feedback should be constructive and positive.
