




Configuring 4jauth on Mac OS X

4jauth is a network that your computer can automatically sign into every time you use it. It may only be used on equipment that is dedicated to a single user. These instructions apply to Mac OS X v. 10.7 and newer.

1. Open a browser and go to: <http://ns.lane.edu/auth>
2. A file called **4j.mobileconfig** will be downloaded. Double-click if it does not open automatically.
3. Click **Continue** when prompted to install.



4. You will be asked if you sure you want to install the profile. Click **Continue** once again.



5. You will be asked to provide a username and password. Enter the standard username and password you use for other 4J services, such as Zimbra.



6. Click the **Install** button.
7. You will be prompted for your computer's password. Type it and click the **OK** button.



8. Close the **System Preferences** window.


9. Go to the Wi-Fi menu at the top right of the screen and click on **4jauth**.



10. A **Verify Certificate** window will appear. Click the **Continue** button in this window.



11. In the next window that appears, enter your computer's password and click **Update Settings**.
12. Click on the Wi-Fi menu again to verify that you are now connected to the correct network. If you are, it should display a checkmark next to **4jauth**.
13. In the Wi-Fi menu, click **Open Network Preferences...**
14. Make sure **Wi-Fi** (aka **AirPort**) is highlighted.
15. Click the **Advanced** button.
16. In the list of **Preferred Networks**, make sure **4jauth** has priority over **4jwireless**. You can do this by clicking and dragging them up or down in the list.



17. Click the **OK** button.
18. Click **Apply** and close the window.
