



Keynote Integration Ideas

Teaching Integration

Daily Message

Save time and foster independence by displaying announcements, reminders and important dates and schedule changes in a slideshow at the start of class.

Rules

Save valuable class time at the start of the year or term by using a Keynote slideshow to present common rules and expectations for your classroom. Added bonus: You can save this as a QuickTime video to post on your website or give to new students to review independently.

Assignments

List class assignments that should be added to student planners. Post weekly assignments on website for students to check against their work. Serves as a resource for students who were absent.

Vocabulary and Site Words

- Review spelling words by having a slideshow of upcoming words rotating at the start of class.
- Introduce words that will be in reading: Pre-teach difficult words to increase student success and comprehension.
- Replace over-used words using a mobile word wall: Brainstorm replacements for common words to add to the slideshow to present during writing.
- Review commonly misspelled words.

Foreign Language

- Introduce new verbs, pronouns and adjectives from other languages and review with students.
- Display grammar equivalents from different languages.

Math

- Review math concepts during class for extra practice.
- Sample problems and solutions.
- Present new concepts with examples of real-world use.

Review

- Jeopardy: Create interactive concept review for students to use in class or independently.
- Study guides: Create pre-test to let students determine which concepts need extra practice.

Slideshows of Student Work or Events

- Showcase images of student projects as examples for other students.
- Slideshow of photos and music from classroom events, field trips, assemblies, concerts and plays.
- Students love to see photos of themselves.
- It is an excellent way to demonstrate and reinforce positive behavior by showcasing students who were caught being good.

Student Project Integration

Science: Periodic Table of Elements

- Students create a slideshow about their assigned element(s).
- Research and present findings about weather, food chains and animal life cycles.

Reading and Writing

- Persuasive Essay: After completing the writing process, students showcase their projects in a multimedia presentation that is saved as a QuickTime movie.
- Book Reports
Students create interactive movies that feature their favorite authors. These videos can be added to the classroom website to share with other students.
- "Ten Steps" How-To Video
Using digital cameras and Keynote, students write detailed instructions for a simple task.
- Digital books or poetry: Have students present creative writing along with their own voice and imagery, including their own artwork and photos that inspire them.
- Digital dictionary: Assign students high-frequency words as well as spelling words to create a digital resource that can be added to the classroom website.

Foreign Language

- Digital books in different languages: Have students translate favorite children's books and create a movie.
- After modeling, have students create their own presentations with audio to improve fluency.

Art

- Create a digital portfolio. Have students capture examples of different art concepts in photos to demonstrate their abilities. Examples include: Color, shape, line, positive and negative space.
- Claymation animation movies: Fractures Fairy Tales. After creating their own version of common fairy tales, students act out their narrative by creating props, sets and characters. Projects are created by placing one photo on each page and using audio to set timing.

Health

- Virtual tour through systems of the body.
- Research healthy eating by investigating nutritional information from popular fast food restaurants.
- PSA: Have students create commercials that promote physical, mental and social health.

History and Geography

- Digital tour of historic events. Create a slideshow to step through a timeline to demonstrate cause and effect.
- Country reports: Have students research and integrate maps, movies, and other data into an interactive slideshow.
