

# Binder Contents and Organization

You will need a good quality 3-ring binder (2"-3" rings) with pocket inserts for your AVID class.

## Required Binder Contents:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Five–six colored tab subject dividers to separate academic classes, including AVID
- \_\_\_\_\_ Zipper pouch to store supplies (a 3-hole punched, heavy-duty, plastic bag with zipper closure also works)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Two or more pens
- \_\_\_\_\_ Two or more pencils
- \_\_\_\_\_ Filler paper (some notebook paper is now available in Cornell note style)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Assignment calendar for each academic class and/or school agenda book
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tutorial logs
- \_\_\_\_\_ Learning logs

## Suggested Binder Contents:

- \_\_\_\_\_ One or two folders with pockets (for paper with no holes punched in it)
- \_\_\_\_\_ One or more colored highlighter pens
- \_\_\_\_\_ Notebook dictionary and/or thesaurus
- \_\_\_\_\_ Calculator
- \_\_\_\_\_ Six-inch ruler
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tips on note-taking and test-taking skills, tutorial guidelines, or other AVID strategy sheets
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sample of note-taking in specific subjects

## The Front Section of Your Binder Should be Organized in the Following Manner:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Binder front cover
- \_\_\_\_\_ Zipper pouch for supplies
- \_\_\_\_\_ Binder grading sheet
- \_\_\_\_\_ School agenda book (*optional*)

## Each Subsequent Section in Your Binder Should Have These Parts in This Order:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Calendar/assignment log

- \_\_\_\_\_ Tutorial/learning logs
- \_\_\_\_\_ Handouts
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tests
