Indicative mood - reports events as they happen
(present, imperfect, preterite)

Subjunctive mood - refer to situations that involve uncertainty, desire, ignorance, emotion or an impersonal opinion.

TIME: refers to the uncertain present and future

Key phrase: Main clause of uncertainty + que

Structure: Simple tense: verb base + verb ending

There are about eight categories that the subjunctive mood can be defined:

1. Desire
2. Ignorance
3. Emotional statement or comment
4. Impersonal opinion
5. Uncompleted action
6. Vague or indefinite antecedent
7. "Perhaps" and "maybe"
8. "Even if"

 O - ue - the o changes to u - dormir - dormímos, dormíais
 C - ie - the e changes to i - mentir - mintímos,
 C - i - the e changes to i - pedir - pidímos, pidíais
