African Research Project - Power Point Option

Your Power Point must be created on the 4J account only, so that there will be no compatibility issues on the day of your presentation.

1) Start by opening the SEHS website (http://www.sehs.4j.lane.edu/), then clicking on '4j Google Docs.'

2) Open the 'Google Docs' link & sign in with your 4j username & password.

3) Click on the 'Create' drop down member & open a 'Presentation' (Google Docs' version of Power Point).

4) *Immediately,* do the following:

A) Click on 'Untitled Presentation' & change the name to:

B) Click 'Share' and type in 'Paulic' in the 'Add people' box.

When my email address pops up, click on 'Share & Save' to link it to my Google Docs account. Please, don't change any settings. I need to be able to make editorial comments.
